- 5. - 9. Moose mentioned that he would like to order shirts with our logo on them so when we go on outings we look cohesive. We are to order them and turn in the receipt to the City for reimbursement.
- 10. Moose discussed the chain of command when you have questions or concerns. Julie made up a list that was handed out. Moose is to be notified and he then will go to Gary Plunk or Vernon Sullivan and they will decide if the matter needs to go farther up the chain
- 11. Julie advised she will be making a new phone list as there are changes.
