Lastly, if COVID cases continue to decrease we will resume in person council meetings in March, with the practice of social distancing.

Bryan Richison – Informed council we will discontinue COVID split schedules. Beginning Monday, February 22, 2021 all departments will resume normal staffing. The Rec Center will also re-open on February 22nd, with the exception of the basketball court (due to the fact that the mask mandate is still in effect) and the pool (due to the broken pump issue). Mr. Richison stated that staff did an excellent job during the recent snow storm.


