REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Motion by Andrew Sutton to approve the agenda as presented. Second by Frank Kutilek. Voice Vote – *Unanimously Approved*.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Motion by Cricket Whaley to approve the minutes from the January 8, 2013 meeting as presented. Second by Ralph Sippel. Voice Vote – *Unanimously Approved*.

QUESTIONS FROM THE FLOOR: None

7a. 2013-01: COMMERCIAL SITE PLAN, KOCH DEVELOPMENT, NEW CONSTRUCTION FOR CLUB FITNESS AT 2255 MICHIGAN AVE (NEXT TO EXISTING BUILDING): There being no one in attendance, Chairman McArthur did not read the staff report.

Del Williams commented that the plans were hard to read; need a north arrow on the plans.

Todd Teuscher commented that the fence is falling over. Mary stated that the city and the developer are aware of this.

Ted Brandt questioned the lighting concern. Mary stated the lighting in question would be for anything new; wall packs added to the building or poles.

Matt Fogarty of Premier Civil Engineering the building will be attached; no gap in between the building; concern with the awnings; two separate buildings with two separate fire walls.

Motion by Andrew Sutton to approve 2013-01, Commercial Site Plan for Club Fitness at 2255 Michigan Ave. with the two (2) conditions:

- 1. The note indicating parking calculations is corrected to reflect 5 spaces per 1,000 gross square feet.
- 2. Bare bulbs, wall packs, flood lights are prohibited. All bulbs must be recesses and not visible from any angle.
