7a. 2014-01: MINOR RECORD PLAT, THEODORE FARMS, PLAT 1A, 3850 VOGEL ROAD: Motion by Jeff Campbell to approve 2014-01, Minor Record Plat for Theodore Farms, Plat 1A, 3850 Vogel with the two conditions:

The variance for the landscape plant material is granted since it will not be injurious to the
public health or welfare; the site is unique since it abuts a residentially zoned property used
for non-residential use; and the variance will not vary the Zoning Code of Comprehensive
Plan.

 The proposed lot 1A will still be non-conforming related to use, lot coverage and lack of landscape material in the new landscape buffer. This lot will be governed by our Zoning Code, Section 5. Non-conforming lots, non-conforming uses of land, non-conforming structures, non-conforming uses of structures and land, and non-conforming characteristics of use.
