

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Michelle Berlingeri, a representative of the non-profit community blood center ImpactLife, requested approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for a "Clinic" to allow for a volunteer blood donation center at 1726 Missouri State Rd, within a "C-2" Commercial District.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Don Miller, Vice President of Network Facility and Support Services, St. Luke's Hospital, requested approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for a "Clinic" to allow for physician offices, at 874 Arnold Commons Dr., within a "C-4" Commercial District. In addition to this request, Staff proposed and Planning Commission concurred to include with this Conditional Use Permit, the existing St. Luke's Urgent Care, located at 832 Arnold Commons Dr.

REVIEW & ANALYSIS:

At its June 13, 2023 meeting, the Planning Commission held a public hearing for the CUP application. Staff found the request consistent with the CUP review criteria contained in the Zoning Ordinance subject to conditions of approval. The Commission had no follow-up questions for the applicant or Staff. There were no public comments on the request.

RECOMMENDATION:

On June 13, 2023, the Planning Commission, by a vote of 5 to 0, voted to recommend approval of the Conditional Use Permit subject to six (6) conditions of approval.

CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT 2023-18

WHEREAS, Don Miller, representing St. Luke's Hospital, has requested a Conditional Use Permit for a "Clinic" to allow for physician offices at 874 Arnold Commons Dr. and St. Luke's Urgent Care at 832 Arnold Commons Dr., within a "C-4" Commercial District known as Arnold Commons Plaza, as provided in the Arnold Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, the Planning Commission has held a Public Hearing, reviewed the application for CUP and associated site plan pursuant to the laws of the City of Arnold, and;

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2023, the City Council found the proposed land use not detrimental to the surrounding land uses.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council hereby issues a Conditional Use Permit to operate a physician clinic and separate urgent care. This Conditional Use Permit shall be identified as C.U.P. 2023-18 and shall be developed in general conformance with City of Arnold Ordinances and with Commission findings with the following six (6) conditions:

- 1. This Conditional Use Permit is approved for the St. Luke's Urgent Care at 832 Arnold Commons Dr. and the St. Luke's Physician Office at 874 Arnold Commons Dr. within Arnold Commons Plaza.
- 2. Activities and operations associated with the clinic shall be physician offices with related outpatient services.
- 3. Activities and operations associated with an outpatient clinic and shall be limited so that overnight stays are prohibited.
- 4. This Conditional Use Permit may be revoked by the City Council if the terms of the permit have been found to have been violated. The procedure for revocation shall require a hearing before the City Council.
- Revocation of this Conditional Use Permit shall constitute grounds for the revocation of all other City licenses and/or permits associated with this business establishment.
- Approval for Conditional Use Permit does not supersede other local, state, or federal requirements.
