REPORTS FROM MAYOR, COUNCIL AND COMMITTEES

Mayor Counts - Stated that COVID-19 has been a big concern and information is changing daily. Rest assured he, Bryan Richison, Bob Sweeney and Chief Shockey are in constant contact to make any adjustments and policy changes necessary to keep citizens and employees as safe as possible. Mayor Counts also briefly discussed the \$26 million in federal grant money that Jefferson County will be receiving to assist the county and its municipalities with COVID-19 related expenses.

Tim Seidenstricker, Ward 2 – Encouraged everyone to attend the Farmers Market on Saturday. Mr. Seidenstricker asked Chief Shockey for an update on the security cameras at the old golf course, to which Chief Shockey informed everyone the cameras are up and running 24/7.

Jason Fulbright, Ward 1 – Stated he is glad to see that Jefferson County seems to be "flattening the curve" in regards to COVID-19.

Vern Sullivan, Ward 3 – Thanked the Mayor and city staff for keeping the city running smoothly during this pandemic.

Gary Plunk, Ward 4 – Asked if anyone has heard from any businesses that they will not re-open after the Stay At Home Orders are lifted.

Brian McArthur, Ward 2 – Asked Chief Shockey if we could keep a police presence at the old golf course for a while so people, without a doubt, know that the City is keeping its eye on the property. Mr. McArthur suggested placing signs along the path at the golf course to indicate how far back into the park people are and how long it will take them to return to the parking area. Dickie Brown informed everyone that Parks & Rec is working on this, as we speak.

Dan Kroupa – Stated he is glad in these uncertain times, in regards to tax revenue, that the County will be receiving the \$26 million in grant funds. Mr. Kroupa reminded council that the City has an ordinance in place that states the City must keep 34% of its revenue in reserve for this type of emergency. If we do need to access these funds, we will need to replace them as soon as possible, after the emergency passes.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS

Chief Shockey – Informed council that there are still active COVID-19 cases in the City and gave a brief rundown of how his department is operating to keep staff safe. Chief Shockey also informed everyone that the County has extended social distancing guidelines through June 15th.

Bill Lehmann – Assured council that staff is keeping a close watch on the financial information and the effects the pandemic is having on tax revenue. Mr. Lehmann also informed council that he will be sending out the budget information for the next fiscal year to department heads within the next week or two.

Tammi Casey – Informed council that City Hall re-opened to the public on May 4th. Staff has implemented safety procedures and it is going well.

Judy Wagner – Provided council with an update on all projects in the city.

Dickie Brown – Thanked council for their support on the new buildings for Parks & Rec and the Street Department. Informed everyone that the Farmers Market is opening this Saturday, with safety procedures in place.

Bryan Richison – Informed everyone that City Hall will be closed tomorrow in honor of Truman's Birthday. Staff is still operating on a rotating schedule and will continue to do so through the end of June, possibly longer if needed. Mr. Richison also discussed the grant money that Jefferson County is due to receive.
